#### **Nomination criteria:-**

- Nominees must have legal right of abode in the UK
- They have positively contributed to the wider UK community through unpaid, voluntary work
- To have been involved in a volunteer capacity for a minimum of 6 months
- Aged 18 and above

The honours system recognises an outstanding Community Heroine, or Group/ Association who have:

- made achievements in public life
- committed themselves to serving and helping Britain
- have made life better for other people or be outstanding at what they do.
- has made an exceptional contribution to the response to the crisis in the UK.
- making a difference to their community or field of work
- enhancing Britain's reputation
- innovation and entrepreneurship
- changing things, with an emphasis on achievement
- improving life for people less able to help themselves
- displaying moral courage
